Highlights of the Board of Trustees Meeting

December 2, 2013

- Library Assistant Bev McGee was recognized at the Nova Scotia Library Association / Library Boards Association of Nova Scotia Conference for her excellent work and contributions to the Library field. Ms. McGee was the recipient of the Emile Theriault Award for Library and Information Technology.
- The Royal Society of Canada is carrying out a study on the status and future of Canada's Libraries and Archives, and has established an expert panel to begin work on the report.
- A *Living Mannequins* fundraiser held at McConnell Library on November 17 included twelve readings/dramatizations from books, which then were paired with food.
- The last *In My Community* storytelling session was held in Louisbourg November 19.
- The Library Board approved the replacement of the Cape Breton County Bookmobile. A call for tenders will be issued in the New Year.
- The Library Board approved the purchase of a new telephone system for Headquarters/McConnell Library. The Regional Librarian will investigate options for replacement of the present system.
